On the Necessity of Summer

Thank God it is summer. We all need it.

Regardless of our age, most of us still have our elementary school calendar ingrained in us. At some deep level we still operate on the idea that we work in the fall, winter, and spring, and vacation in the summer. It does not matter if we go to work every day or never go to work, most of us think of summer as sabbath time – time to rest, relax, and be re-created. And so we should.

Just as there are seasons in nature, so there are seasons of the spirit – times for fruitful work and times for fallow rest. If we ignore these interior seasons, we do so at our own peril. We become like the ground that loses its nutrients and can no longer nurture good growth.

We are not machines made for perpetual productivity. We are not “human doings.” We are “human beings” made in the image of God and, like God who rested on the seventh day, we need to rest, to look back on what we have co-created in the last year and see that it is good and rest in it.

The time has come for us to claim our recreation as part of our spiritual life, remembering that recreation at its best is “recreation.” God’s creation is constantly being recreated. That is what happens in the seasons of nature. That is what happens to us during a good golf game (if such a thing exists!).

The time has come for maranatha moments, when meditation rises up within us, not because we are trying, but because we have finally taken the Lord’s advice to, “Be still and know that I am God.” (PS 46:11)

The time has come for our vacation to be a holiday. The word “vacation” is rooted in the Latin word for “vacuous” and the word “holiday” is rooted in the old English words for “holy day.” So may your summer sabbath be a holiday of recreation.

Adult Education: A Glimpse of the Autumn

What a great year we had with adult education at St. Mark's! The popular VUCA series at 9:00am on Sundays in Morrill Hall kept a dedicated crowd coming to hear various stellar speakers make compelling connections between the world and the church. Mother Anne's ever-popular Monday Morning Class covered a number of topics relevant to children, families, and subjects such as practical spirituality, marriage, and Jungian psychology as it pertains to the life of faith. Bishop Grein's Wednesday Bible Study had a devoted following as they delved into miracles, parables, the Psalms, the gospel of Luke, nativity stories, and apocalyptic literature. And we were fortunate enough to have parishioner Alison Gruseke, a PhD candidate in Old Testament studies at Yale, teach a short course on the Psalms at the end of the program year.

We are busy planning another full year of adult offerings. On the horizon is a new Sunday mornings at 9:00am series in which we will take a mountain-top tour of the Bible. Each Sunday we will discuss a major Bible story, beginning with Genesis in September and going straight through the Bible so that we end with Revelation in June. If you feel you don't have a grasp of the Biblical story, this is for you! (And for those of you who would actually like to read the entire Bible in the course of the year, stay tuned for details about our Bible Marathon).

Also on Sundays, from 11:15-12:15 (right after the main service), we will offer a year-long class on the foundations of the faith. We will cover all the main topics pertaining to the living out of the Christian faith (Bible, prayer, basic theology, ethics, history, and so forth) in a class that will prepare you for greater participation in the life of the parish, membership, or adult Confirmation. ...or perhaps you'd just like to fill in the gaps in your knowledge of the faith. All are welcome.

Mother Anne plans to start the year on Monday mornings with a new parenting book by psychologist and theologian Dorothy Martyn called "Beyond Responsibility: Children, Parents, and Responsibility Revisited." Next will be a discussion group based on James Hollis, PhD's book, "Finding Meaning in the Second Half of Life." Both books will be available in the Lion's Den.

For the Wednesday Bible Study group, Bishop Grein is planning to finish the study of apocalyptic literature and then move on to the synoptic gospels, focusing especially on how the faith of the gospel writers attempts to speak directly to the faith of the reader. He will then lead a study of John's gospel.

More details about all these offerings will be in the August edition of the Roar.

During the fall, winter and spring, the store is alive with volunteers and customers buying and selling and chatting while sipping coffee, nibbling cookies, wrapping gifts, welcoming friends, etc. The store is also open and welcoming during special events at church. In addition The Lion's Den offers a Winter Author Series which has become a much anticipated event for parishioners as well as for the community.



But the work that keeps the store filled with unique items, the pleasant, time-consuming process of “nabbing” new volunteers, the scheduling of our author series requiring conversations with publishers and authors, and most especially and certainly the hardest, but most enjoyable part of being the manager of The Lion's Den, the work of “the buying” - is done during the summer months. This mind-boggling feat of “knowing” what to buy for our store is accomplished in many ways, and in various scenarios. With the help of my talented volunteers, we begin to sift through what is left from the year of our best-sellers and begin the

ordering process to insure we always have our “skeleton stock.” Then we try mighty hard to figure out how to make the “old stuff” look fresh by adding just a few interesting and complementary products.

Then begins the part I generally do alone: sifting through the dozens of catalogs piled up from Christmas and surfing the even greater number of online catalogs - to see what's new and what we think our customers might love. Most physical catalogs go home with me and keep me company during the summer afternoons and evenings when I watch lazy games of baseball and old movies. Other catalogs are lucky to travel with me to various friends and family's houses where they might get sandy, wet, muddy or covered with hay and horse hair, depending where my summer takes me. On September 12, Opening Sunday, The Lion's Den will be pristine, and filled with books, gifts, cards and music that will make you happy you have a church store at your parish.

Confirmation 2010-2011

Last August the clergy and I made some changes to the Confirmation program at St. Mark's. This resulted in the suspension of the 7th grade Confirmation class and the creation of a Jr. High youth group. The changes were immediately successful, and the 7th grade class became the core of a new era and ethos of youth ministry at St. Mark's. We owe this success to committed support despite uncertainty. Thank you.

I write to report that a Confirmation program will be offered to 8th graders in the 2010-11 church program year. Though it remains in the best practices of the Episcopal Church—and the recommendation of the Bishop of Connecticut—that Confirmation take place in the late-adolescent period, we believe our unique context currently supports the 8th grade year as the best opportunity for an intensive program. The conversation about moving Confirmation to 9th or 10th grade will remain open in the coming years. It is not expected that 8th graders attend both Confirmation and youth group, but I will not discourage such enthusiasm.

About the Program: Confirmation 2010-11 will be a full **academic-year program, beginning on September 12th and likely ending May 14 or 21.** The group will meet weekly on 'Program Sundays' after Church (11:30-1pm). Lunch will be served by parents on a weekly, rotating basis. In addition to the classroom component, every confirmand will be assigned an adult mentor from the parish with whom to meet throughout the year for one-on-one discussions. Additionally, confirmands will be expected to attend Church weekly, including Holy Week liturgies. A final one-on-one meeting with me will be scheduled in April or May. There will also be at least 2 field trips. A detailed game plan (syllabus) will follow as it is developed.

Please stay tuned. Until then, if you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me. I genuinely look forward to the upcoming year with this very special group of young people.

St. Mark's Music Ministry

Now is a great time to begin thinking about singing in a choir this coming fall. With choirs for all children, youth and adults there are many opportunities to participate. Children's Choir Registration form may be found in this newsletter and also on our website.

Our *Joyful Noyze!* serves boys and girls from pre-school (age 4) through 2nd grade. This energetic and quite honestly joyful group

meets from 4-4:30pm Tuesdays during the school year. In the course of the half hour, we find our voices, play musical games and sing children's church music and enjoy each other's company praising God. Most often there is play time on the nursery school playground following choir. *The Joyful Noyze* begins Tuesday September 14th.

The *Boy and Girl Choristers* meet from 4-5:00pm on Wednesdays. This group of highly spirited 3rd through 7th graders sings very regularly at the 10:00am service. In addition to developing their individual voice each chorister also learns to use his or her voice in an ensemble. In addition to learning songs and anthems for use in church members are given the opportunity to acquire a broader knowledge of music. This fall we will return to the Royal School of Church Music training scheme in which each student advances level by level as greater knowledge of music and the Church is attained. Merit certificates and awards are earned as each new level of musicianship and scholarship is reached. The Boy and Girl Choristers will begin on Wednesday September 15th.

Young persons from grade 8 through high school are encouraged to participate in *Youth Choir*. With many still in the parish who have gone through the chorister program we hope to encourage the further participation of these wonderful individuals on a seasonal basis. This group traditionally sings anthems and songs for 2 and three parts, and has also enjoyed exploring gospel, non-western music and the music of Taizé. Please watch for further information about options for days and times that the *Youth Choir* will meet, and participate in our liturgical life

Currently there are places open for adults the *Parish Choir*. This ensemble of around forty talented volunteers and a few professionals sings each week at the 10:00am liturgy. A highly energetic and enthusiastic group, the *Parish Choir* continues to grow both in number and expertise as the repertoire is expanded with new music each year. In addition to singing on Sundays, the *Parish Choir* is augmented with singing friends and parishioners to form the *St. Mark's Chorale* for several special concerts each season.

Members of our choir and guests formed the touring *St. Mark's Singers* and traveled to England where they were the resident ensemble at Norwich Cathedral in 2006. The ensemble in July 2011 has been offered a residency at Chester Cathedral. Participation in the *Parish Choir* does not require extensive previous choral experience, but the ability to use and understand one's voice is needed, along with the desire to continue to learn and excel while enjoying the company of others. Rehearsals are Thursdays from 7:30-9:30pm and Saturdays from 4-5:30pm. Attendance at one of these is required to sing on Sunday. Singers who are college age and beyond are encouraged to contact Brian-Paul Thomas at the church for an appointment. The *Parish Choir* begins at 7:30pm on Thursday September 9th.

After a hiatus we are restarting a handbell choir, *The St. Mark's Ringers*. We have been blessed with a complete set of handbells from the White Chapel Bell Foundry in England. These finely tuned bells played one, two and three at a time combine to form a special non-vocal choir which can add so much beauty to our liturgies. Whether playing a piece specifically composed for bells or adding a festive flourish to a hymn or psalm the *St. Mark's Ringers* add a joyful flare to our services. Ability to read music is not necessary for participation; however the ability to count and a sense of humor are essential. The *St. Mark's Ringers* rehearse for 30-40 minutes at 6:30pm on Thursdays beginning September 16th.



Well you have done it again! On behalf of our Board of Directors, and our clients we thank you for all of the fans and air conditioners your church parishioners donated via your appeal.

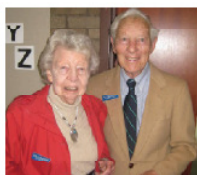

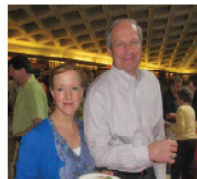
